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COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

HC321 Understanding the Basics of Hospice Chaplaincy

3 credits

(No prerequisite required)

Description: This course is for professionals interested in improving their delivery of spiritual care in palliative care. Students will look at the differences between chaplaincy care, spiritual care, and pastoral care. Additional topics include training requirements and credentialing process for Board Certified Chaplains, ethical practices, spiritual assessment and documentation, cultural competence, inclusion, communications skills for families, and death, dying, and grief.

HC322 Fundamentals of Spiritual Care in Palliative Care

3 credits

(No prerequisite required)

Description: This course reviews the history and philosophy of hospice and palliative care. Case studies and reviews of existing guidelines are introduced with an emphasis on spiritual care as an essential domain of palliative care. Social and cultural influences, ethics, family systems and group facilitation, and the role of the chaplain as a member of the interdisciplinary team are also examined.

HC323 Advanced Practice Spiritual Care in Palliative Care

3 credits

(Prerequisite Required – HC322)

Description: This course builds upon the knowledge gained in SC322. Topics addressed include clinical practice guidelines for quality palliative care, family-physician conferences, continuous quality improvement, application of cultural competence and inclusion, the continuation of care, and caring for the hospice team.





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COURSES CONTINUED

HC324 Spiritual Care Concerns at the End of Life

3 credits

(No prerequisite required)

Description: This course covers spiritual experiences that are common to people facing the end of life. Topics include loss of identity, connectedness, end of life, and issues surrounding various types of grief. Further, students will better understand spiritual assessments and interventions along with approaches to spiritual conversations, self-care, self-awareness, and self-compassion for spiritual caregiving professionals that regularly encounter end-of-life scenarios.
