COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

CH329 Pediatric Chaplaincy Care

3 credits

(No prerequisite required)

Description: This course introduces some of the unique issues of providing chaplaincy and spiritual care to children and their families, especially for chaplains and other spiritual care providers assigned primarily to adult care settings and only occasionally interact professionally with children.

PC331 Advanced Topics in Pediatric Chaplaincy

3 credits

(Prerequisite IS Required – CH329)

Description: This course takes a deeper dive into Pediatric Chaplaincy and Palliative Care and examines how spiritual care interventions and close relationships may promote patient and family well-being. Special attention is placed on diverse populations and pediatric critical care issues.

PC332 Trauma-Informed Pediatric Chaplaincy

3 credits

(No prerequisite required)

Description: Trauma-informed care has become a necessary part of chaplaincy. This course raises awareness of the signs and symptoms of trauma and brings light to the biological, relational, and spiritual aftereffects. Trauma-specific interventions that facilitate healing are addressed.

PC333 Pediatric Palliative Care

3 credits

(Prerequisite IS Required – CH329)

Description: This course covers effective strategies for caring for infants, children, teens, and young adults who have a serious terminal illness. Concepts such as ease of suffering, pediatric care delivery, and pediatric patient and family support will be addressed.
