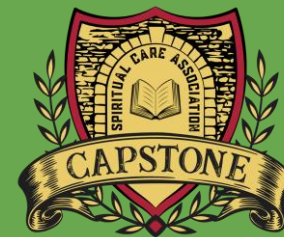

The **CAPSTONE Executive Diploma Program in CPE Supervision Theory** is designed for those delving into the intricacies of teaching and supervising in Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE). Aimed at equipping individuals with the theoretical foundation crucial for CPE supervision, this specialty program comprises four courses that delve into the core theories essential for any supervisor, whether they are in training, serving as an educator fellow, or a candidate. This program is tailored to enrich the educational journey of aspiring supervisors, focusing on developing a robust theoretical base in CPE supervision rather than certifying them as supervisors. It challenges participants to explore and articulate their educational philosophy, understand their approach to personality psychology, and define their teaching theology or philosophy. Furthermore, it encourages the integration of these domains, presenting them as the foundational pillars for this comprehensive series of courses.

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COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

AL321 **Adult Learning Theory I** **3 credits**

(No prerequisite required)

Description: This course focuses on introducing students to a variety of theories around adult learning. Students will read and discuss adult learning theories as well as consider how these theories might be implemented in best practices with adult learners. Because of the nature of the certificate program, special emphasis will be placed upon these theories being applied within a practitioner context.

CH440 **Narrative Spiritual Care and Counseling** **3 credits**

(No prerequisite required)

Description: This course introduces the postmodern counseling approach called Narrative Theory and presents the techniques used in this type of counseling, empowering students to integrate narrative theory with the practice of narrative spiritual care counseling. Students will learn the concepts of externalizing stories, re-authoring stories, re-membering stories, narrative questions, and narrative letter writing. This course also addresses how to listen to stories, how to respond, and the importance of asking timely, well-formulated questions. The crucial concept of learning the counselee's "language" is explored and a five-step model of narrative counseling is introduced.

CP421 **Human and Spiritual Development** **3 credits**

(No prerequisite required)

Description: This course reviews major streams of theory in developmental psychology and discusses the biological, neurological, spiritual, and physiological factors that affect human development, functioning, and behavior. Ethical and culturally relevant strategies for promoting resilience and wellness across the lifespan will be discussed.





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COURSE DESCRIPTIONS – CONTINUED

SC441 Theological Reflection 3 credits

(No prerequisite required)

Description: This course introduces theology as a practice of creative and critical reflection on humanity, the world, God, and/or source from a multi faith perspective. Theological themes in dialogue with insights from the natural sciences and current social justice issues that challenge today’s communities will be addressed. By connecting the theological tradition with science and social justice, students will consider how to reflect on and express faith in an informed dialogue with other fields of study that are essential to a holistic understanding of our world today.
