COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

CH351 Foundations of Addiction and Recovery Chaplaincy 1 credit

(No prerequisite required)

Description: This course introduces chaplains to the essential aspects of addiction, covering its psychological, biological, and societal roots. It emphasizes the critical role of chaplaincy in addressing these challenges, drawing on the principles of addiction science to comprehend its impact on individuals and communities. The curriculum aims to provide a compassionate and knowledgeable approach to spiritual support, laying a solid foundation for understanding the complexity of addiction and preparing chaplains for further advanced studies and practical application in their spiritual care practice.

CH352 Deepening Understanding of Addiction and Recovery Chaplaincy 1 credit

(Prerequisite is Required – CH351)

Description: Expanding upon the initial concepts, this course explores advanced topics related to addiction, such as co-occurring disorders, contemporary research in treatment, and consideration of different recovery models. It underscores the significance of integrating spiritual care within treatment plans, the spiritual aspects of addiction, and the role of faith and spirituality in the healing process. Through this course, students will enhance their comprehension of the nuanced issues surrounding addiction and learn to apply these insights in their chaplaincy work.

CH353 Practical Skills in Addiction and Recovery Chaplaincy 1 credit

(Prerequisite is Required - CH351)

Description: Centered on actionable skills, this course prepares chaplains to support recovery journeys effectively. Key areas include conducting spiritual assessments, creating personalized spiritual care plans, managing crisis interventions, and leading support groups. Special emphasis is placed on developing empathetic communication and active listening skills, alongside navigating the ethical complexities inherent in addiction recovery spiritual care thus equipping students for the nuanced demands of chaplaincy in real-world settings.

CH354 Specialized Techniques in Addiction and Recovery Chaplaincy

1 credit

(Prequisite is Required - CH351)

Description: This advanced course delves into specialized tools and strategies for chaplains working with individuals facing addiction and recovery. Topics cover the application of spiritual assessments, evidence-based interventions suited for recovery settings, and methods to foster spiritual growth and resilience. The curriculum is designed to facilitate collaborative work with healthcare teams, integrating spiritual care into holistic treatment approaches. Practical training in assessment, intervention design, and effective evaluation prepares students to make a substantial impact in the domain of recovery support, for the individuals, families, and communities affected by addiction.
