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COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

1 Required

SCC218 Chaplaincy Department: Building and Maintaining 1 credit

(No prerequisite required)

Description: The candidate will have 4 weeks of self-guided course work to complete this online course. The building a Chaplaincy Department course will address the components of developing and managing a high-quality department, based on the latest research data and proven best practices. Through a step-by-step process, the course will provide the candidate with resources and samples of the details to be addressed, including planning and implementation.

3 Required Pick 3 of Next 4

SCC219 Delivery and Continuity of Care for Chaplaincy and Spiritual Care

1 credit

(No prerequisite required)

Description: This course will guide the candidate through an overview of health care delivery and continuity of care with information, activities, and resources to increase understanding of the United States health care system. It will also encourage the learner to consider how chaplaincy and spiritual care is, is not, or can be delivered and continued throughout a person's experience and health care journey. Candidates will be provided with opportunities to articulate their new knowledge and consider practical ways to integrate it into their scope of practice, provision of care, best practices and protocols. The candidate will receive in the mail a printed Study Guide for this course.

Pick 3

SCC220 Continuous Quality Improvement Within Health Care: What We Do Matters

1 credit

(No prerequisite required)

Description: The candidate will have 4 weeks of self-guided course work to complete this online course. This course is designed to enable learners to be a full participant in CQI processes and to establish and sustain a CQI program for a chaplaincy or spiritual care service using Lean and Six Sigma. Participants will learn the basic language in order to recognize CQI's underlying assumptions, language, and processes. The module will teach assumptions and language that is pretty much universal to all CQI systems and the language particular to Lean Six Sigma which is the most widely used system. Participant will learn how to set up and run simple Lean or Six Sigma Projects and be able to avoid the most common mistakes in this process. Examples of hospital practice will be provided.

Pick 3

SCC222 Supporting the Interdisciplinary Team: When Care is Tough 1 credit

(No prerequisite required)

Description: Chaplains and other spiritual care providers are often called upon to provide emotional and spiritual support to members of the interdisciplinary team, especially in times of crisis and stress. This course will provide information, practices, and resources on topics including compassion fatigue, vicarious trauma, burnout, one-on-one and small group work, and the appropriate use of ritual.

Pick 3

SCC223 HIPAA Compliance: What to do with Information

1 credit

(No prerequisite required)

Description: In 1996, the United States Congress passed The Health Insurance Portability & Accountability Act (HIPAA). It is one of the most asked-about and misunderstood issues in health care. The course, What to do with Information: HIPAA Compliance, gives a history of HIPAA, and focuses on its implications of HIPAA for the health care industry, health care chaplains and spiritual care providers, and patients.
