COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

TI351 Foundations and Impact of Trauma-Informed Chaplaincy 1 credit

(No prerequisite required)

Explore the history, terms, and evolution of trauma-informed care, and understand the broad impacts of trauma on individuals and society.

Description: This course combines an introduction to trauma-informed care with an in-depth look at the impact of trauma. Participants will explore the history, terms, and goals of trauma-informed chaplaincy, understanding its evolution and current relevance. The course also delves into the wide-ranging effects of trauma, including historical blindness, societal impacts, and the nuances of Post Traumatic Stress and Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. This foundational knowledge sets the stage for more advanced learning in subsequent courses.

TI352Infrastructure and Tools of Trauma-Informed Care1 credit

(No prerequisite required)

Learn the guiding principles of trauma-informed care and gain practical skills in utilizing various tools and techniques for effective practice.

Description: Focusing on the practical aspects of trauma-informed care, this course covers the guiding principles and assumptions essential to this approach. Participants will learn about creating environments conducive to trauma-informed care and explore a variety of tools and techniques, including standardized assessment inventories and interventions. This course equips participants with the knowledge and skills to implement effective trauma-informed practices in their work.

TI353Specialized Populations and Interaction Techniques1 credit

(No prerequisite required)

Focus on tailored approaches for children, adolescents, and veterans, and master the skills for meaningful and supportive encounters in chaplaincy.

Description: This course addresses the unique needs of children, adolescents, and military veterans in the context of trauma-informed care. Participants will understand the specific considerations required for these populations and learn tailored approaches and interventions. Additionally, the course covers the art of the encounter in trauma-informed chaplaincy, focusing on preparing and managing the space, assessments, and providing hope and voice to clients.

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COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

TI354Self-Care, Team Support, and Envisioning Healing1 credit

(No prerequisite required)

Focus on self-care and team support strategies to prevent burnout and explore methodologies to foster healing and empowerment in trauma-impacted individuals.

Description: The final course emphasizes the importance of self-care and team support in preventing burnout among chaplains and their teams. It explores the relationship between trauma and burnout, offering strategies for maintaining mental health. The course also devles into envisioning a healing future, discussing the potential for healing from trauma, strategies for stress mitigation, reconnection, and empowering clients towards a 'new normal'.
